Travel Protocols, Pre-Arrival

1. Registration



All delegates are expected to register at this link: <https://portal.dijito.one/registration-start/global-bioeconomy-summit-2024>. The registration fee for individual participant is US\$200. There is a limited number of student tickets available at US\$100. The registration system captures delegates biodata including passport size photos and copies of respective identification documents (National ID card, Passport, Student ID). Foreign delegates are advised to register using Passports.

Upon completing your full registration, you will receive an invitation letter for the Summit. This letter will be emailed to you and can be used to fulfill entry requirements for Kenya.

2. Entry Requirements for Kenya



Entry into Kenya for foreign delegates is subject to **obtaining Electronic Travel Authorisation (eTA)** at least seventy-two (72) hours before the travel date. For online application of the eTA, please visit: <https://www.etakenya.go.ke/en>

Citizens of the countries of the **East Africa Community (EAC)** are exempt from completing the eTA. The East African Partner State countries include Burundi, Democratic Republic of Congo, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania, and Uganda. Entry to Kenya requires a **national passport** and not a national identification card (ID).

Other Requirements:

- Delegates are responsible for complying with any travel measures stipulated by the country of departure and destination, and the respective airline. **Delegates coming from yellow fever endemic countries should have valid vaccination certificates (vaccinated ten (10) days) before departing for their destination country.**

Note: Kenya is classified as a country with risk of yellow fever transmission and therefore delegates are required to have a valid yellow fever certificate upon entry.

- Delegates should consult their medical practitioner for recommendations for other vaccinations and precautions that may apply to them.

3. Air Ticket



The dates for GBS2024 are **23 – 24 October 2024**. Plan to arrive on the 22 October and depart 25 October. The main port of entry to Nairobi, Kenya, is the **Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA)**.

5. Meals and Refreshments



The Summit package for the 2-day Summit will be taken care of by the organisers. This has been factored in the **Registration fee** and includes meals and refreshments.

6. Airport Transfers



Some hotels provide complimentary or paid taxi/shuttle transfer services to key locations, including the Summit venue. Check with your hotel for available options.

Delegates are free to use their own transport arrangement. To get around Nairobi, ride-hailing services such as Uber, Bolt, and Little offer convenient, frequent, and affordable services. Taxis are also available, but as they are not metered fees should be agreed upon before departure. 7. Airport Meet and Greet Desk



For travelers arriving via **Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA)** between **20 – 22 October 2024**, there will be a **GBS2024 “Meet and Greet” information desk** at the exit points (luggage collection area) of both Terminal 1A and 1E to provide needed support.

A **Courtesy Van** will be available through the meet and greet desk, providing GBS2024 delegates with transportation to **Safari Park Hotel** at **scheduled time intervals**. 8. Language



English will be the main language during the Summit. Translation services are not available.

9. Weather



According to the forecast for Nairobi, Kenya, the temperature in October 2024 are comfortable with low of 15 °C, mean of 20 °C, and high of up to 26 °C.

10. Time



Kenya is within the East Africa Standard Time zone (EAT). It is three hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT +3).

11. Foreign Exchange Currency



Foreign currencies can be exchanged at the banks and Forex Bureaus. The currency of Kenya is the Kenya Shilling (Ksh). It is issued in 1000, 500, 200, 100 and 50 bank notes and 40, 20, 10, 5 and 1 coins. Currency exchange points are available at banks, the airport and at major hotels. 12. Electricity Supply



The standard electrical current used throughout Kenya is between 220 – 240 volts with a frequency of 50 Hz. The electric plugs and sockets are of the D/G. It is recommended that delegates carry their own adaptors.



13. Stay Connected



There are several options for staying connected to the internet while in Kenya:

- **Travel Packages:** Contact your mobile provider to inquire about available travel packages and their costs.
- **Local SIM Card:** Purchase a local SIM card upon arrival. Safaricom, is a major provider and has a counter at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA).
- **eSIM Services:** If your phone supports eSIM, consider using an eSIM service provider.
- **WiFi:** Utilize the WiFi available at the Summit venue and your hotel.

14. Security



Ensure that you have emergency contact numbers with you at all times. Make sure you have your valuables (cash, passport, lap-top, and mobile phone) with you at all times.
